- Received supplemental grant for \$500,000
  - Purchased 500 chromebooks
  - o 25 smart TVs
  - Stadium TV in gym
  - Invested in Freshman seminar curriculum
    - Training teachers this year
    - ASD coming online with Freshman Academy 24-25, so we are ahead
    - Hired a Principal (Jen Palmisano), Counselor, and security staff for this program
    - Will have career and college fairs in the Spring
- Service has 25 AP courses (up one class for last year)
  - African-American studies AP class added
  - AP scores have been going up over the last four years and more students are enrolling
- Adjusting Dress code Focusing on being ready for careers and college
