### Treasurer's Report

### Principal's Report

- We're now down to 1 lunch due to the cafeteria being closed. Only 185 freshmen now included in all school lunch
- Warehouse scheduled to pick up tables from library and café next week
- Serving Area may be closed either in December or May. School cannot be occupied when everything is pulled out. An area in the back of the gym is designated.
- 1 July, ASD will begin to follow the Federal Law passed in 2006 to only have healthy foods available in schools during school hours.
- Staffing meeting today. We've lost 2 SPED teachers and adding 5 .6 - .8 teachers.
- Capital grants we may possibly be getting would include \$1.5 m for the Grant Fraser Memorial Amphitheatre, \$20 k for music instruments, \$250 k for our field; should have an answer in summer
- Bleachers will be installed after the ground has thawed, hopefully by the fall.
